The EWB Fellows Program exists to develop a cadre of Systems Change Leaders by equipping them with the opportunities, competencies and skills needed to build a more thriving and sustainable world. Every year we recruit 25-30 outstanding people for the 12-month Fellowship, placing successful candidates in one of our early-stage Ventures located throughout Sub Saharan Africa. This Fellowship opportunity is with LishaBora and is based in Kiambu, Kenya.

About LishaBora

LishaBora is a young social enterprise that uses high value dairy feeds and services to provide farmers with what they need to earn a living from their animals. In 2008, 11.8 million cows in Kenya produced over three billion liters of milk, over 70% of which was produced by smallholder farmers. This is nearly half the production level of other similar economies. Our feeds and services enable smallholder dairy farmers to increase milk production by up to 30% while reducing costs by as much as 60%. Our mission is to re-design the relationship that smallholder farmers have with feed suppliers and develop a holistic approach to solving one of the regions biggest problems. We are growing rapidly with the goal of raising 500k USD in 2017 and becoming self-sustainable in early 2018.

About the role

The main goal of this position is to help drive the development of products and services that can be used by smallholder farmers and help them increase the profitability of their farms. Our goal is to bring the highest quality goods and services that are typically reserved for large scale farms to the smallholder



farmer of Kenya. We will be using a variety of feeds from dairy meal and silage to minerals and supplements as well as services to help increase animal health and profitability of the farm.

As a Director of Product Development for LishaBora, your responsibilities will include:

- Working with farmers to determine the best products to overcome their specific challenges
- Working with our operations team to determine the best feed products
- Helping to design products and services that we can use to help increase the viability of smallholder practices.
- Develop balanced dietary supplements for LishaBora
- Work to develop LishaBora's range of products and services
- Help to bring new products to the market by collecting impact and effectiveness data
- Conduct R&D Testing of feedstuffs both as lab analysis and field trials for products

This job will also require you to:

- Work with the other team members in order to develop, test and implement new products and services.
- Work from the small office that acts as the company headquarters near Kiambu Kenya.
- Be able and willing to do a diverse set of tasks, applying skills across disciplines. Being a startup, things are always changing and roles often cross many fields of study
- Have a drive and passion for working with small business that are impact focused
- Willing to take risks in order to achieve something new and exciting
- Have an open mind, be creative, have fun and enjoy new experiences

Skills & Qualifications

Since LishaBora is still small and early stage, we are looking for someone who is:

- Able to work in an open and small business setting, often collaborating with colleges on various different aspects of their job.

The role will require:

- Experience in animal husbandry, animal feed formulation or similar fields
- Understanding of animal biology
- Working knowledge of forages, roughages and other feed-stocks
- Good project management skills
- High levels of organizational skills

Compensation

All costs relating to the placement are either paid for directly by EWB (airfare, insurance, vaccinations, trainings) or indirectly through a living stipend, which covers food, living expenses, local travel, etc. Fellows also receive an honorarium that can be used to assist with repatriation costs. The stipend covers basic living expenses for a modest lifestyle in your placement country. You should not expect to save money during this year or use the stipend to cover previous expenses (e.g. student loans). Additionally, EWB offers a range of benefits including insurance, a settlement allowance, professional development opportunities, and more.
