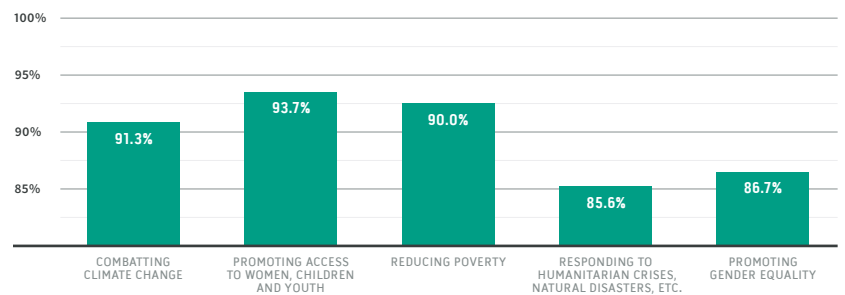


YOUNG CANADIANS SPEAK OUT ON GLOBAL DEVELOPMENT

When it comes to global development, young Canadians have strong views. A recent survey by Engineers Without Borders Canada shows overwhelming support for government action on global development issues like climate change, poverty and gender inequality.

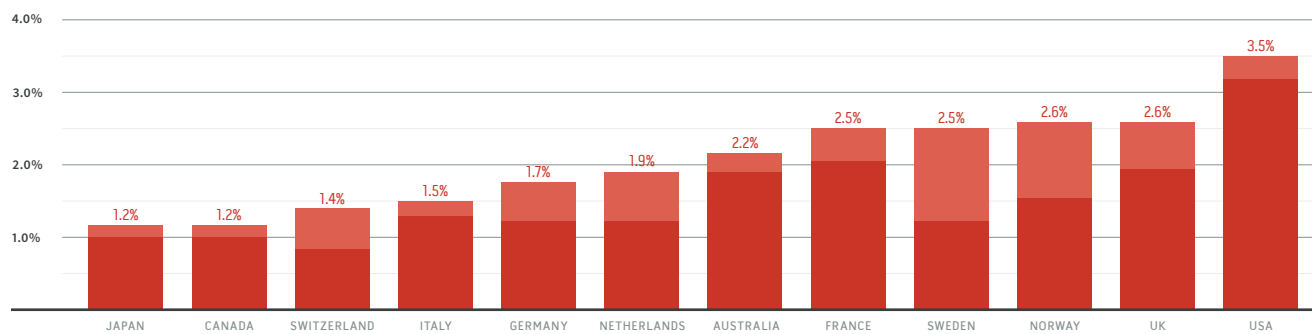
Only 35% of respondents believe the federal government is responsive to the views of young Canadians on international development.

Nine in ten (91%) of respondents support combatting climate change, while 90% advocate for reducing poverty and 87% call for action on gender inequality.

Compared to our G7 counterparts, Canada ranks last in the level of development assistance provided.



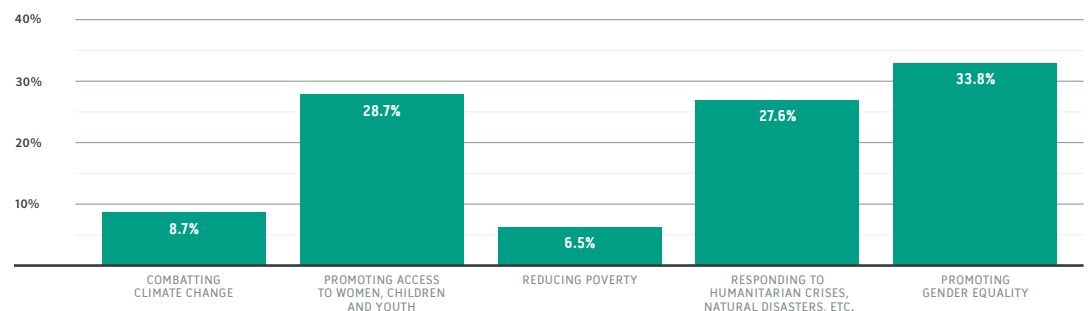

87% of respondents believe the new U.S. administration will have a negative impact on global development.

Only 9% of respondents believe Canada is succeeding at combating climate change, while just over half (57%) feel the federal government is succeeding at advancing key international development issues overall.

Eight in ten respondents say now is the time for the Canadian government to increase its investment in international development programs.
