Responsibilities:

- Consult with Venture Gender Inclusion Specialist to build Gender Lens Investing Strategy;
- Use Gender Score from EWB as baseline as GLI strategy is built and implemented with particular emphasis on applying a gender lens to identify new and/or untapped markets, increase productivity, effectively mitigate risks and costs, enhance economic empowerment of marginalized groups including women and identify opportunities to increase female talent and leadership within EWB Ventures;
- Research and identify relevant social enterprises, investment partners, and opportunities in the impact investing space across West Africa;
- Prepare and present key deal materials including initial investment summaries and investment memos and gender assessment;
- Support portfolio management, including capital raising, financial modeling, network building, monitoring and reporting;
- Research and develop thought pieces around key themes or sectors, sharing lessons within EWB and externally via blogs/social media; and
- Other duties, as developed by the team.
